Cancellation of deputation of doctors.

Sir,

I am directed to say that deployment of doctors at places other than the places of their posting resulted in dislocation of health care in assigned places of posting. As such, Government have been pleased to cancel all such deployment/deputation in G.O.No.43866/H dt.30.10.96.

In spite of cancellation of deputation orders, it has been brought to the notice of Government ~~that~~ that some doctors are still working on deputation basis without joining ~~the~~ their original places of posting.

It is therefore requested that the doctors who are continuing as on deputation may be relieved forthwith with instruction to join in their places of posting immediately on pain of disciplinary proceeding.

Nor relief of doctors by the concerned Chief District Medical Officers will be viewed seriously and action as deemed proper will be initiated against them.

A report of compliance with regard to relief of the deputationist may be faxed by return positively.
