No. MS:II.IM.20/90(pt) /H., In pursuance of Provisions of Rule made vide Notification No.16359/A. dt.30th Sept,1955 of the Home Deptt., the State Govt. after careful consideration have decided to regularise the periods of unauthorised absence from duty on the part of the members of the Orissa Medical & Health Service & Orissa Medical Education Service in connection with cease work agitation mentioned below in the following manner.

- 1) 7.9.88 to 8.9.88
- 11) 21.9.88 to 27.9.88

2. The principle of "no work, no pay" will regulate the ~~ERREX~~ cases of unauthorised absence from duty mentioned above and they would not be entitled to pay and allowances for the periods for which they did not work.

3. However, such periods of unauthorised absence from duty shall count towards -

- 1) Annual increment in relaxation of the provisions of Rule 79 of the Orissa Service Code and
- 11) Qualifying service for the purpose of terminal benefits in relaxation of provisions of Rule 44 of the Orissa Pension Rules,1977.

4. This has been concurred in by the Finance Department in their UOR No.843 CS-I dt.28.12.90.
